and

§ 1
The subject of this Agreement is the granting of a non-exclusive, paid licence (including the right to grant further licences) without territorial restrictions and for an unlimited time, to use the work
mentioned work – to organise exhibitions for Harte Zeiten / Ciężkie Czasy and their promotion, hereinafter referred to (regard of the number of the works made available) as the Work.
§ 2
<ol> <li>For granting the licence referred to in § 1 of this agreement, the Gallery will pay the Licensor the amount of PLN 800.00 words: eight hundred zlotych) gross.</li> <li>The remuneration referred to in section 1 will be paid by the Gallery to the Licensor's account within 14 days from the dof delivery of the bill by the Licensor.</li> <li>The above amount referred to in section 1 of this article constitutes the total and definitive remuneration to the Licensor for the provisions contained in this agreement.</li> </ol>

<ul> <li>The Licensor confirms that they are the author and owner of the work referred to in § 1 of this agreement and that they have all the rights, including copyright and related rights to the work, to the extent enabling its use in the fields mentioned in the agreement and to the extent determined by the purpose of this agreement. Under the declaration made, the Licensor, relation to the completion of the agreement, bears full responsibility, while undertaking to repair all damages in full an releasing the Gallery from any liability.</li> <li>The Licensor authorizes the Gallery to use the work referred to in this agreement in the following fields:</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>for recording and multiplication: production by any technique of an unlimited number of copies, e.g. in catalogue or folder form, including printing, photographic, reprographic, audiovisual, magnetic recording, digital techniques,</li> <li>for distribution by other means: public display, projection, playback, broadcasting and rebroadcasting, including on t Internet, storing on a computer, transmission via a multimedia network, including on the Internet, and other types of publication in such a way that everyone can access it from a place and at a time individually chosen by them.</li> <li>marketing of recordings made, including by sale.</li> </ul>

<ol> <li>Any amendments and supplements to this agreement shall be made in writing under pain of nullity, in the form of an annexe</li> <li>This agreement has been drawn up under Polish law, and in matters not regulated by this Agreement, the provisions of the Code and the Act of February 4<sup>th</sup>, 1994 on Copyright and Related Rights shall apply.</li> <li>Any disputes arising in connection with the performance of this agreement, after exhausting the amicable path, shall submitted by the Parties to the Court having jurisdiction over the seat of the Gallery.</li> <li>The agreement was drawn up in two identical copies, one for the Gallery and one for the Licensor.</li> </ol>
